





Build progress

- We've added a data migration for the new Level A ISPF activity
- This has given us a template journey (currently a combination of the level B & C journeys) for adding a new ISPF activity, which we'll hide from users until the new fund is finished
- We'll focus on customising this journey according to the activity level and ODA/non-ODA type in the next sprint





Importing Level B Budgets





Budget Importer

Currently BEIS users can add budgets at level B. However, this process is done manually and can be a time consuming task for users.


We had a requirements session and design collab with BEIS in order to understand what features are needed and what it would look like.

We then created a first iteration prototype and tested it with users.



Budget import - Route in

Users were able to easily find the budget heading and knew instinctively to click on the "download CSV template" button.

Fund RODA ID refers to Level A funding, users felt that this field was not needed as it would already be included in the activity RODA ID.

There were also concerns that **Partner Org Name** also does not need to be within the template.

"I don't understand Fund RODA ID, as GCRF and newton funds are not an ID. They are the Level A funds."

"I'm not sure I'd necessarily want the partner organisation's name in there, are these all mandatory? I have a partner org id on our internal source sheet, so might not need it"

The Budget type code was not valid - Users originally entered "ODA", instead of "0". (0 - Direct or 1 - ODA")

Users mentioned the need for clear guidance on zendesk in order to be successful in the upload.

Type | Financial year

There is less margin for error when using numbers as opposed to typing free text.

Financial year: User entered 2023 instead of 2023-2024. Need for clear guidance.

"As long as there is guidance on zendesk, then entering the data should be fine"



Confirmation of upload

User would then export budget reports by fund, in order to check that what they have entered is in the correct column and that the totals are correct.

The ability to edit and/or delete a budget was also acknowledged by users.



"Because you can add multiple budgets per year - if you reupload (e.g. if you make an error) it will duplicate. If you want to remove it, you need to go in and delete it manually"



Comments


Users need to add comments to budgets as it would be helpful for BEIS users to differentiate between different sorts of budgets.

Having comments is a way of future proofing and helps with the QA process as well as being able to demarcate budgets if more funding comes in (Extra allocations).

"Without comments it is a bit like working in the dark".



CSV Column refinements



"It makes more sense if 'Type' were followed with providing org, providing org type and IATI reference. Populated if type is 1 - OODA"



What next?

• Analyse and Scope out needs for Level C and D budget imports, so that we can build a first iteration.



Commenting on Level B Activities






Levels C and D commenting

Commenting on activities via the UI was was previously only available:

- at Levels C and D
- for users from partner organisations
- on activities tied to an open report






Level B commenting

Useful for BEIS users to be able to:

- add comments on Level B activities,
 e.g. relating to budgets
- via the UI and bulk upload
- whether or not there's an open report

New functionality allows for this in the UI




Report Quality Assuring (QA) queries






76% of QA queries in Q1:

"The forecasts seem incongruent with the status"




Over half of these:

"The status is 'finalisation' but there are no future forecasts"




Why?

- In theory, POs hold the final payment until they've received the final expenditure statement
- So: we expect a forecast after the end date of the activity
- Some pay it early, so have no forecasts to report




Proposal: split the status in two





A third of the status queries:

"The status is 'Spend in progress' but there are no future forecasts"



Why?

- Sometimes POs have received all of the money, but had an extension to spend it
- In these cases the activity is in progress, not further payments


New priorities and roadmap






We've reprioritised our roadmap

- We'd originally planned to start implementing ISPF a couple of sprints ago to get a head start before the reporting deadline
- We pushed this back to focus on the aforementioned usability wins while some of the finer details of ISPF were being ironed out
- We'll be focusing on fleshing out the ISPF build over the coming few weeks








We've gathered requirements for other features

- Budgets new requirements have emerged since we started development:
 - Revisions
 - Bulk importing Level D budgets
- These add some complexity, so we'll be scheduling these in for after the initial MVP for the new fund
